



When you host a Kehillah Kiddush (regular Saturday morning)

Saturday morning Shabbat Services begin at 9:45 a.m. Services are held in Chapel Emanu-El. The Kiddush is held in the kitchenette part of the Chapel. **Tot Shabbat Services** begin at 9:30 a.m. and is generally in the Sanctuary (except during a Bar/Bat Mitzvah)

Please bring (for 25-40 people) for the adult service:

- 1 large bottle of Manishevitz wine
- 3 bottles soda (2 liters),
- 3 bottles of juice (64 oz. apple or white grape)
- 2 Challahs
- 3- 4 dozen bagels (have sliced in store if possible)
- 1 large fruit platter
- 1 large veggie platter
- 2 side items (hummus dip, couscous salad, tuna salad, egg salad, Israeli salad, sliced cheeses)
- 24 oz. cream cheese
- 2-3 varieties of sweets/desserts (cookies, brownies)

Please bring the following for 30-50 children/adults for the Tot Service:

- 5 bottles of juice (64 oz. apple or white grape)
- 2 Challahs
- Small bagels, muffins, or graham crackers
- fruit

The Kehillah provides: Tablecloths, serving trays, paper goods, utensils, salt & pepper shakers. These items are found in the cabinets.

Host Instructions:

- Please contact the office during office hours for key/lockbox information.
- Set up the food for the adult and the tot Kiddush
- If the table cloths become dirty, please take them home, launder them, and return prior to the following Friday for that week's use.
- Clean up the food and wipe the tables following the kiddush.
- Take home food that will easily spoil.
- If you have unopened boxes of crackers/cookies or bottles of juice/wine/soda, you may donate those for the Kehillah Religious School, Preschool, or special event programs by leaving them on the counter or in the refrigerator in the kitchen.
- Lock all doors and return the key to the lockbox before you leave.
