



When you host Shabbat B'Yachad **Potluck Lunch**

Shabbat B'Yachad begins at 9 a.m. and will be held throughout the facility. The Potluck Kiddush luncheon will be held in the Sanctuary wings.

Please bring:

- 3 bottles of Manishevitz wine
- 10 bottles soda (2 liters)
- 10 bottles of juice (64 oz. apple or white grape)
- 2 Challahs
- Plastic silverware, cups, plates, napkins for 200 people
- A vegetarian/dairy main dish for 20 people from each hosting family
- A side dish or dessert from each hosting family

All non host families bring **either a** main dish, salad, appetizer; or dessert. They will put non-perishable items (baked goods, breads, etc.) directly on the buffet tables in the sanctuary and refrigerated items to the main kitchen in the Education Wing.

Host Instructions:

- Set up the food on both rows of tables. Refrigerated food should be placed towards the end of the service.
- Place 2 challot on "challah" plate with challah cover and salt shaker (for the bima). Then place two challot on each set of tables.
- Pour wine into the Kiddush cup for the rabbi.
- Clean up the food and wipe the tables after the kiddush.
- Take home food that will easily spoil.
- If you have unopened boxes of crackers/cookies or bottles of juice/wine/soda, you may donate those to the Kehillah Religious School, preschool, or special event programs by leaving them on the counter in the kitchen or in the refrigerator.
