Lastly, parents can choose as many theme week camps as they want to fit their summer schedules.

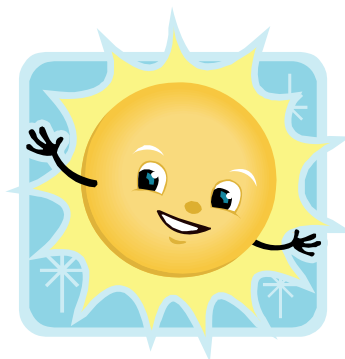

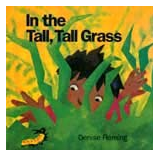
Week #4—July 11-15
